Dedicating \$9.9 million from the State Opioid Response grant, the Colorado Department of Human Services, Office of Behavioral Health (OBH) **provides six mobile health units specializing in medication assisted treatment (MAT)** to improve access to MAT in rural and underserved areas of Colorado.

OBH partners with Front Range Clinic, Jefferson Center and San Luis Valley Behavioral Health Group to operate the units.

- Nurse (LPN or RN)
- Counselor (CAC I-III)
- Peer recovery coaches

- Naloxone distribution
- Referral to wraparound services
- Syringe disposal
