You know I weigh 130 lbs too, but I'm only five ft. four inches. You are three inches taller than I am. My sister Alvina is 5'2" and she weighs 110 lbs. Delia is about 5'2" also and her weight is about 150 lbs. I understand she's in and out of

the hospital all winter. I never got a card from any of my family this year, I will not write to them either.

Alvina's the only one who called on Xmas eve to wish my a happy New Year + Xmas.

What are your plans for the future? You've graduated high school and now you should get a grant of some kind and go to college. Don't waste your young life doing nothing.
